# Community Foundation Grants over \$50,000 to Hendricks County Organizations

The Community Foundation awarded the first round of Deedee Daniel Opportunity Fund grants at the Annual Dinner in April. The grants, totaling \$51,100, will benefit 14 organizations and projects who service thousands of Hendricks County residents.

"We received 48 letters of intent which resulted in 14 organizations receiving grants from the Deedee Daniel Opportunity Fund and one anonymous donor fund," says Janet Haley, executive director of the Community Foundation. "We have so many valuable organizations servicing Hendricks County; we are working to increase our endowments so we can fund more requests each year."
