### **David H. Kiebach Smile Fund Awards Grants to Four Hendricks County Organizations**

**Avon, IN** – The David H. Kiebach Smile Fund at the Hendricks County Community Foundation recently awarded grants to four Hendricks County organizations for their work in our community.

Diana Kiebach presented checks to the four grant recipients: Get Real inC., Sandlot Ministries, Inc., Strides to Success and Susie's Place. Get REAL inC will use the grant monies for their upcoming Get Real event, featuring Britt Nicole, on February 26, 2011. Sandlot Ministries' grant will help them continue their work as an instructional baseball and softball sports ministry. The grant to Strides to Success will help the general operation of their Plainfield facility which provides unique equine experiences that promote learning opportunities that strengthen and develop lives. Susie's Place will use the grant money for general operating of the Hendricks County Child Advocacy Center.

The David H. Kiebach Smile Fund was established at the Community Foundation in memory of Diana's husband, Dave, to help local causes and organizations treat the needs of the community's children. When asked why the fund had the word "smile" in the name, Diana replied, "Dave had a smile that was contagious. You just couldn't help but smile when you were around him."

Since 1996, funds held at the Community Foundation have awarded over \$7 million in grants to local organizations and projects.
