Hendricks County Community Foundation Announces Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Recipients

Two Hendricks County students have been named recipients of full tuition, four-year scholarships as the Hendricks County Community Foundation 2008 Lilly Endowment Community Scholars.

Jennifer Bozell, daughter of Dale and Debbie Bozell, and Valerie Campbell, daughter of Mark and Patsy Campbell, will receive full tuition to the Indiana college of their choice and an \$800 yearly stipend for required books and equipment. Bozell attends Brownsburg High School and Campbell attends Covenant Christian High School. They were awarded this prestigious scholarship based on significant community service, outstanding academic achievement and leadership skills.

The Hendricks County Community Foundation received 64 scholarship applications from Hendricks County students. After the applications were reviewed, seven students were chosen to be interviewed. From this group, two Lilly Endowment Community Scholars were selected and the remaining five finalists will receive a \$1,000 scholarship from Avon Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery: Elizabeth Flood, Cathedral High School; Steven Henke, Covenant Christian High School; Joseph Macri, Cascade High School; Ross Patten, Avon High School and Victoria Schopper, Cathedral High School.

The scholarships are the result of a statewide Lilly Endowment initiative to help Hoosier students reach higher levels of education. Indiana ranks among the lowest states in the percentage of residents over the age of 25 with a bachelor's degree. There will be 216 scholarships awarded statewide.
