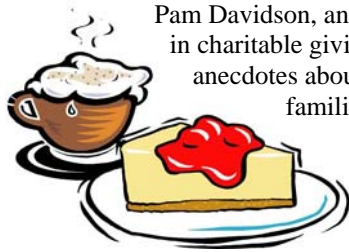

Leaving a legacy through planned giving

Ben and Dorothea Anderson of Plainfield had made a difference for Plainfield and Hendricks County for many years. Dorothea worked with the Migrant Camp Ministry in the early 1960s, they both delivered Meals on Wheels three times a month, and they were active in their church and many other charitable and civic organizations. Ben and Dorothea were quiet and modest about their philanthropic work, but if there was a need in their community, you knew they would be willing to help meet the need.

Ben and Dorothea will be missed, but are going to continue to make a difference for charitable projects and organizations in their community because they planned ahead. Dorothea owned property in Hamilton County that had been in her family for three generations. As she and Ben were aging and not quite as healthy, she decided it was time to sell the property. She and her family looked at their options, taking into consideration the capital gains tax issue and what they wanted to achieve with the gift God had given them.

After consulting an attorney and their accountant, they found that they could establish a charitable trust. How does this work? The land was deeded to the charitable trust and the trust sold the land. During this process, Lilly Endowment was matching irrevocable gifts to the Community Foundation. This gift had a major impact on the assets of the young Community Foundation.

The Andersons felt this was a winning combination: good for the community, their retirement, and the legacy they wanted to leave.

Because the charitable trust sold the land, there were no capital gains taxes paid, the Andersons received a charitable tax deduction, and the best part for them was that during their declining years they received a monthly income from the interest on the money that was invested in the trust.

Since Ben and Dorothea have both passed away, the principle amount in the trust will be placed in the Anderson Family Fund. The income from this fund will help the charitable projects that were so near and dear to Ben and Dorothea. They were very happy knowing that because they planned ahead their charitable work would continue. What a wonderful story of caring people that made a difference for over 80 years and will continue to make a difference for generations to come.

Foundation receives \$250,000 "Sustaining Resource Development" grant

The Community Foundation is proud to have been awarded a \$250,000 grant through Lilly Endowment's Sustaining Resource Development (SRD) Program. The Hendricks County Community Foundation will use this grant money to:

- Increase public awareness of the Hendricks County Community Foundation
- Build the total endowment to \$10 million by 2010 in order to continue meeting Hendricks County's growing needs
- Upgrade the infrastructure of the Community Foundation

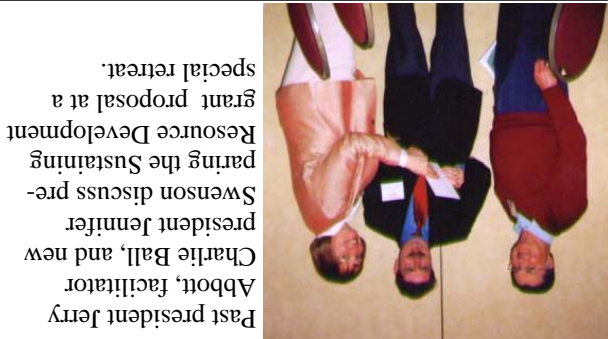
